Reference-No. 2021/297. The start date is April 1st, 2022. The position is available for three and a half years. In principle, the position can be divided into two part-time positions.

Anthropology in Konstanz is international, theory-guided and strong in research. The Working Group of Prof. Beyer is internationally well connected; our working languages are German and English.
